City of Tarok: Little Cottage

You can resize the files if you want a smaller (or larger) sized miniatures in your game, these files are good to 28-32mm sized miniatures without changes.

The finished model with the base will be 4.7 inches tall, base is 4,7x3,2 inches. You do not need any support material to print this model, you can turn off that setting in your printer.

We have printed this model at 0.16 mm layer height, 8 percent infill and 210C with eSun PLA+, using a 0.4 mm nozzle. We used the 2.7 version of Cura as a slicer, it gave us much better results than the new ones. These numbers may vary based on your printer and the material you use.

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Resizing the files:

You can resize the files if you want to print the building in another scale. They will work at 100% with 28mm figures and games.

These are the recommended settings to get other sizes:

140% - 40mm
115% - 32mm - heroic sized miniatures
100% - 28mm - standard RPG miniatures with one inch base
54% - 15mm - most boardgame items (Joan of Arc) and wargames
36% - 10mm - for wargaming
22% - 6mm - for wargaming

You can use these numbers in your slicer before printing.

Content:

You can see 3 folders next to this PDF file. The content of the „**Base with working doors**” is what you need if you want to print the model with a working door at 28mm scale. You'll find two bases in it, one with holes for the windows where you can place a transparent plastic piece making a glass effect, and one without that slot.

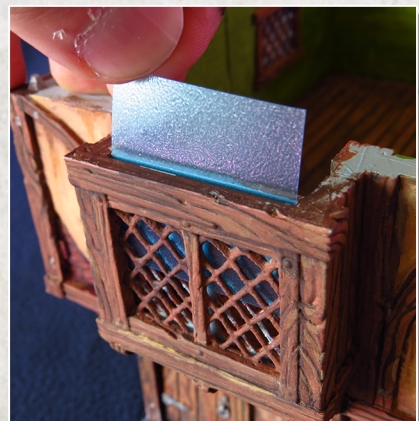
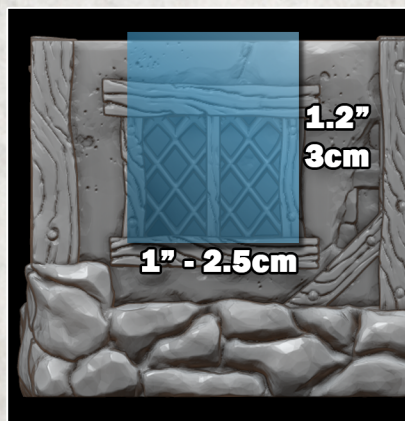
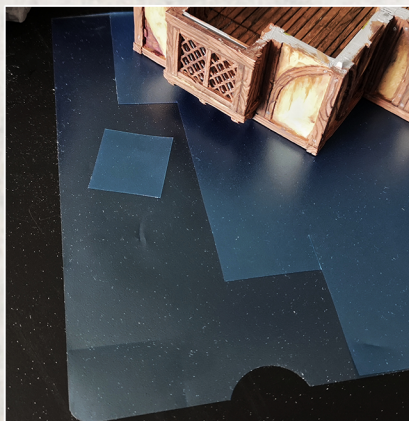
If you resize this building at 10mm scale you'll probably lose the grid of the windows. If you need a house at that small scale please use the files from the „**Scaleable**,” folder, these models have a thicker grid in the windows and even a merged version if you need them in one piece.

The „**Roofs**,” folder contains a cleaner and a damaged roof so you can make your models more diverse.

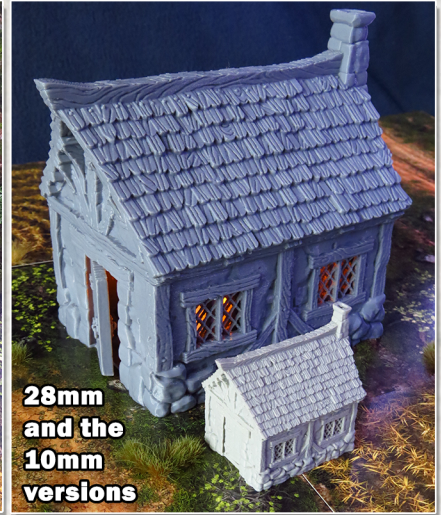
How to add glass to your windows:

- 1, Get a cheap transparent folder from a pen and paper shop.
- 2, cut out two pieces in the sizes you can see below.
- 3 place them in the slots in the windows.

This will work only if you printed the **base_with_window_holes.stl** !

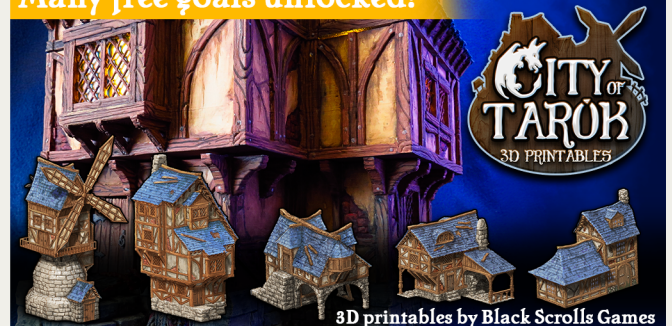


**Cottage with other City of Tarok buildings at 10mm scale
